HOW TO GET A BOOK THIS SUMMER:

To get a book from the library this summer, you will need to put a book on hold. I will see the hold request, pull the book(s) for you, put your name on it and leave it on a table in the front of the school on Wednesdays during summer library hours. You just "grab and go!"

Each student can check out up to two books each week.

HOW DO I PUT A BOOK ON HOLD?

The first step is to find the book in the researcher. You can search by title, author, subject, etc.
