Our school mascot, RIDER, reminds students to be **Respectful, Inclusive, Determined, Exemplary, and Responsible.**


## PBIS:



- Building resiliency in our students










In all testing areas, Fox Hollow either meets or exceeds both the district average and the state average. Testing occurs at the beginning of the year, middle of the year, and the end of the year. RISE testing takes place every spring.

## Trustlands Goals:

- By May 2025, a minimum of 80% of all K-3rd grade students will demonstrate grade level proficiency in reading, based on scores from the End of Year Acadience scores.
- By May 2025, a minimum of 62% of all 4th-6th grade students will demonstrate grade level proficiency in mathematics, based off of RISE scores at the end of the year.
